The loan (in the form of debt securities issued under the Multi-issuer Deed) itself is transacted through the same process as LGFA's usual loan process. LGFA will normally be able to process applications within ten working days to determine whether LGFA will make Climate Action Loan (CAL) financing available. Accordingly, LGFA encourages member councils and council-controlled organisations to complete and return the application form well in advance of the borrowing requirement. LGFA must also receive any requested documentation before giving feedback on the application.
